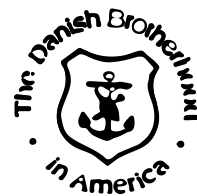

### **REMINDER NOTE FROM DB 29 TREASURER REGARDING 2018 DUES:**

In **January 2018** Lodge 29 membership **dues increased to \$30 per member.**

Please read the portion of the new approved By-Laws for clarification.

7.4 The **new member** must **pay a \$25.00 initiation fee** before being initiated into the Lodge. The new member will then begin to pay annual dues effective the start of the next calendar year. Juveniles are exempt from initiation fee.

7.5 **Members must pay annual dues of \$30.00.** Dues will be based on members' age on January 1 of that year.

7.6 Juveniles are eligible for membership if a parent or grandparent is a member in good standing, and are exempt for payment of dues up to the age of 18. **Full time students between the ages of 18-25 can submit a written application to the Executive Board for a possible dues exemption.**

7.7 Members exempt from paying dues, in addition to juvenile members under age 18, include members at least 80 years of age, members honored by membership in the lodge for 50 years or more, members who are in the military service of our country, and other members specifically exempted from paying dues by a majority vote of the lodge.

7.8 **Members of the Lodge under the age of 18 may not vote.**
